## 5 USEFUL TIPS:

- 1) USE YOUR CAR TO CHANGE CLOTHES AND LEAVE YOUR BAG IN IT
- 2) PAY ATTENTION TO ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS THE SPEAKER WILL TELL YOU
- 3) FOLLOW EXACTLY THE START PROCEDURES
- 4) ALWAYS THROW YOUR TRASH INTO THE APPOSITE WASTE-BINS
- 5) USE THE BOTTLE OF WATER TO COOL OFF AND HYDRATE DURING THE RACE



### How to get to Jesolo

On Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May try to be early in advance; in case of sunny weather many people will go to the beach, and you might find queues.

PAY ATTENTION!! From 6.30pm the roads of the course will be closed; you might have difficulties in reaching the start line and you should park your car near the Hospital of Jesolo. Book your parking space [HERE!](#)

#### **BY CAR**

From Milan

Take the A4 motorway heading towards Venice. Having passed the Mestre bypass, follow the directions to Marco Polo airport and then to Jesolo.

From Brennero

Take the motorway 22 heading towards Verona, then take the A4 motorway heading towards Venice. Having passed the Mestre bypass, follow the directions to Marco Polo airport and then to Jesolo.

From Tarvisio

Take the A23 motorway heading towards Udine, then take the A4 motorway heading towards Venice. Exit at the toll booth of Noventa di Piave/San Donà di Piave, then follow the directions to Jesolo.

From Trieste and Udine

Take the A4 motorway heading towards Venice. Exit at the toll booth of Noventa di Piave/San Donà di Piave, then follow the directions to Jesolo.

When in Jesolo, follow directions to Piazza Milano.

#### **BY TRAIN**

The nearest train stations are Venezia-Mestre (40Kms) or San Donà di Piave one (25Kms). If you get out at the Venezia-Mestre train station you can take the line no. [10a](#) of the ATVO bus till Lido di Jesolo.

If you arrive at San Donà di Piave train station, take line no. [19A](#) till Lido di Jesolo.

Afterwards, when in Jesolo, take bus no. [2](#) to reach Piazza Milano.

#### **BY PLANE**

From Venice (Marco Polo)

If you get to Venice "Marco Polo" Airport you can take ATVO bus no. [10a](#) to Lido di Jesolo.

For info and tickets visit the website [ATVO](#).

Da Treviso (A. Canova)

If you get to Treviso "A. Canova" Airport you can take bus no. [351](#) to reach Mestre train station and from here the line [10a](#) to reach Jesolo.

For info and tickets visit the website [ATVO](#).

Afterwards, when in Jesolo, take bus no. 2 to reach Piazza Milano. For info and tickets visit the website [ATVO](#).

If you prefer to walk to piazza Milano, it is 3 km away.

#### **BY MOTOR BOAT FROM VENICE**

From Venice take motor boat no. [12](#), [14](#) or [15](#) and get out at the final stop Punta Sabbioni. After that take bus no. [23A](#) to reach the bus station. From here you can take bus no. [2](#) or walk to reach Piazza Milano.

### Car Park

700 meters away from the start and finish area there will be a **dedicated car park with limited spaces**, only people booked in advance can park.

The car park is **guaranteed and will be guarded** by operators **from 9am** on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> to **2am** on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> May, a **shuttle service will take you to the Village and back to the car park**.

### Bib number pick up

On **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> May**, you will receive an email with the confirmation letter, that you must present at the bib number pick up desk; it is the only document to be accepted to get your starting number.

The bib number can be picked up at the **Moonlight Village in Piazza Milano** in Jesolo on

\* **Friday, May 19 from 3pm to 8pm**

\* **Saturday, May 20 from 9am to 6pm.**

When getting the bib number remember to have the confirmation letter, an identity document and the missing documents if requested on the confirmation letter.

**DON'T PRINT the confirmation letter, just show it on your Smartphone.**

**Important notice: if your registration is incomplete, you won't take part in the race.**

### Race pack pick up

After getting the bib number, remember to take your race kit and the official technical t-shirt which can be customized by "[IL NEGOZETTO](#)" - you could ask to have your name or your surname or even your nickname on it. **Book [HERE](#) your customization!!**



### Recommended equipment

If you run over 6' pace per kilometer, we recommend you to run wearing a headlamp.



### Official photos

Download the Pica APP from [Apple Store](#) or [Google Play](#) ....after the finish line you could view your race photos! Keep smiling! The PICA photographers will get shots of you during your race. Look for them along the race course and when you see them ...smile ☺.

After the race visit the website [getpica.com](http://getpica.com) or open the app, type your PICA CODE and have a look at your photos



### Check the list! Is something missing??

Before leaving home or the hotel check if something is missing:

- The documents to get the bib number
- The proper clothes to run (suitable for the weather conditions!!!!)
- Some dry clothes to get changed after the race



### Toilets and changing areas

Inside the [Parco Grifone](#) there will be many toilets and changing areas for all participants, please, respect the environment which welcomes you and use the toilets, not the walls of the houses around you!!!!



### Personal Kit Bag

**IN ORDER TO AVOID GATHERING, WE ASK YOU TO USE YOUR CAR OR YOUR ROOM OF THE HOTEL AS A CHANGING ROOM AND BAG STORAGE.**

For those who reach Jesolo by public transport, a bag storage service and a covered area for changing areas will be provided at [Parco Grifone](#), just few steps away from the start line.



### The Start

The start is scheduled at about **8.15pm** (time may vary due to organizational needs) **on Saturday May, 20** from Jesolo - Via Danimarca. The changing areas and the toilets will be near the start line, in [Parco Grifone](#), few steps away from the start line.



### Corral access

Your starting corral will be clearly identifiable by the color of the bib.

The access to the individual starting corrals will be manned by our staff who will allow access only to athletes with bibs matched to each corral.

To access your corral, follow the signs that will be posted throughout the area and strictly respect the time that will be indicated in the confirmation letter.



### Refreshment and sponging stations

On the race course, starting from kilometer 5, you will still find refreshment stations with [San Benedetto](#) water every 5 kilometers, from the refreshment station at the 10<sup>th</sup> Km mark, there will also be [Palmisano](#) biscuits and starting from the 15<sup>th</sup> Km mark you will also find fruit and [ProAction](#) supplements.

**You will have the possibility to take bottles of water at the refreshment stations so you can use the water both to hydrate and to cool off.**

**THERE WILL BE NO SPONGING STATIONS BUT ALONG THE BEACH (FROM KM 17<sup>TH</sup> TO KM 20<sup>TH</sup>) YOU CAN USE THE SHOWERS TO COOL OFF. Press the button, use the shower but do not leave it open!! Water is precious!**



### Do not mess around!!!

**WE COUNT ON YOU!!!!**

**To preserve the territory, we ask you not to throw waste, bottles, litter, but to deposit them in the appropriate containers or to take them with you during the race.**

**Remember to empty the bottles before throwing them away, they can be very dangerous!!!!**



### The race course

The racecourse of the Jesolo Moonlight Half Marathon is flat and fast, perfect to improve one's personal best.

The only difficulties are between the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> km marks as there is a sharp turn.

At the 10<sup>th</sup> km mark there will be an intermediate chronometric point.



### Craft Pacing Team

In the race there will be the teams of guardian angels of the big group of "Craft Pacing Team" who will lead you during your race and will make you reach your goals! These pacemakers will be identified by colored balloons that guarantee to finish the race within a set time. These are the times available: **1h25', 1h30', 1h35', 1h40', 1h45', 1h50', 1h55', 2h00', 2h15', 2h45'**.

Remember when you are at the Moonlight Village to go to their stand, maybe you will meet the one who will help you during the race.



### Withdrawal from the race

Should you be unable to finish the race, do not panic! You may stop and take one of the sweep buses which will take you to the first aid station in Jesolo.

Ambulances and medical motorbikes will be available on the racecourse. In addition, the [BLS-RUN-TEAM](#) runners will run with you, they are part of a special group of runners ready to step in in case of reanimation or immediate defibrillation need



### Maximum time

The time limit to pass at km 10 is set at 1h15'.

The time limit to pass at km 15 is set at 1h55'.

The time limit to complete the race is set at 2h45'.

After these times the organization will no longer be able to ensure the complete closure of the race path.



### After the finish line

The finish line is in **Jesolo** in **Piazza Milano**.

After the finish line, you will find a water refreshment station and receive the well-deserved finisher's medal.

**WE COUNT ON YOU!!!**

**Help us! Keep the finish line clear for those who arrive after you... DO NOT STOP here keep walking!**



### Final refreshment station – Parco Grifone

A bit further on, in Parco Grifone, you will be given the final refreshment bag with [San Benedetto](#) water, [ProAction](#) supplements, [Palmisano](#) biscuits, snack [Morato Bread](#), fruit and [Bavaria](#) beer to toast to your performance.

Here you will find the official photographers that could take shots of you and your friend to remember your experience.



### Moonlight Party by Radio Bella&Monella and Radio Piterpan

Do not leave the Jesolo after the race!!! You are invited at the Moonlight Party in Parco Grifone, to celebrate together with your medal of participation around your neck. [Radio Bella&Monella](#), [Radio Piterpan](#) and the beer [Bavaria](#) will keep up the rhythm and the party!!



### Awards Ceremony

Immediately after the finish, the first three men and the first three women, who will reach the finish line, will be awarded.
